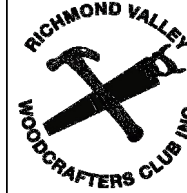

Membership Fees

Annual Membership for current members \$60.00

Fees for New Members (when joining during July)

Joining Fee	\$20.00
Membership - Full Year	\$60.00

When a new member joins during the year, the Joining Fee applies plus a Membership Fee reduced by \$5 per month up to the date he/she joins.

Note: If a person joins the club during June, he/she will pay the Joining Fee and the Full Year Membership for the following year only.

Procedure for a new member joining the club

Note - new members cannot access the workshop until this procedure is complete

- The prospective new member completes the 'Application for Membership' form
- The Constitution, Member's Information Booklet and Code of Conduct documents are sent to the prospective new member.
- The 'Application for Membership' is to be presented and voted on at the next Committee Meeting.
- the prospective new Member is advised by email or in writing of the outcome
- If approved, he/she has 20 days to pay the appropriate Joining and Membership Fees.
- The member's OH & S Register and Competency Sheets are printed.
- the new member is now able to attend the workshop and complete the OH & S induction training as appropriate before commencing work.
