- ❖ The competition will be conducted in accordance with the "**Conditions Of Entry**"

TWEED VALLEY WOODCRAFTERS CLUB.**

- RVWC Members taking part in the competition will be required to be present at Tweed Valley Woodcraft Association Club Room Murwillumbah on Saturday 1st July 2017.
- Members exhibiting items will be required to have them at RVWC Club Workshop Friday 23rd June no later than 1pm.
- Members exhibiting will pay an entry fee of \$3.00 per entry and have entry forms completed on delivery of items to RVWC on Friday 23rd June, in accordance with Show Categories list 2017.
- Items for the exhibition will be transported by car to Murwillumbah Meetings Rooms on Monday 26th June by RVWC at no cost to exhibitors.
- Items to be transported by RVWC will be craft type items no furniture or bulky items, will be taken in the car.
- Furniture and bulky items will be the responsibility of the exhibitor to have delivered to TWEED VALLEY WOODCRAFTERS CLUB ROOMS before 1pm Monday 26th June 2017 entries will be accepted in accordance with the Show Categories list 2017.
- Exhibitors agree to abide by the Rules and Conditions as set down by the TWEED VALLEY WOODCRAFTERS ASSOCIATION.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. The Competition is open to financial members of the Tweed Valley Woodcraft Association and the Richmond Valley Woodcrafters Club Inc.
2. Entries close at the TVWA Clubrooms on Monday 26th June 2017. Early entries welcomed. Late entries will NOT be accepted
3. TVWA & RVWC Members may enter items in as many categories as they wish, a single item cannot be entered in an in multiple categories.
4. Members may enter more than one item in each category. An entry fee of \$3 00 per item applies
5. The Competition Committee reserves the right to determine which category an item is to be entered.
6. Each entry will be displayed with the item number and member number. Any maker's identification must be covered up.
7. Each entry must be declared on the Entry Form as "NFS" (not for sale) or with a selling price, if it is for sale.
8. All entries must be the work of the entrant
9. Entries in the "Novice Section" are to be the work of a club member who has no previous competition experience in the particular category the item is entered.
10. If an item is fragile and is not to be handled a small "Do Not Handle" sign can accompany the item.
11. Responsibility for delivery and collection of entries rests with the competitor
12. Delivery of entries will be accepted at the Clubhouse on Monday 26th June. Entries must be on display before judging commences. No Late entries accepted.
13. Entries must remain on display until the completion of the exhibition unless sold before hand. Please make alternative arrangements if you are unable to collect your entries personally.
14. All reasonable care, but NO RESPONSIBILITY, will be taken for items whilst in the possession of representatives of the Tweed Valley Woodcraft Association.
15. The Judges decisions will be final. No correspondence or discussion will be entered into.
16. Certificates will be awarded to "Best in Category", "Runner Up", "Highly Commended" judgements.
17. The "BEST IN SHOW" award will be selected from "Best in Category" winners
18. TVWA reserves the right to photograph all entries and so preserve a record of participation and use for promotional purposes

Show Categories List 2017

For Both Open & Novice Competitors

- CAT. 1 Turned, laminated, segmented or decorated article, any size.
- CAT. 2 Turned bowl, under 250mm diameter.
- CAT. 3 Turned bowl, over 250mm diameter.
- CAT. 4 Turned platter, under 250m diameter.
- CAT. 5 Turned platter, over 250mm diameter.
- CAT. 6 Turned box any size.
- CAT. 7 Turned vase or hollow vessel.
- CAT. 8 Turned spindle or combination spindle and face-plate turning.
- CAT. 9 Box, dovetailed or other. Wood only.
- CAT. 10 Carving, sculptural or relief in wood.
- CAT. 11 Scroll saw and/or Intarsia, any size.
- CAT. 12 Bandsaw box, any size.
- CAT. 13 Any wooden item used in a kitchen.
- CAT. 14 Any wooden household item. Clocks, barometers, lamps etc
- CAT. 15 Furniture, large. Over 500mm² footprint, approximately.
- CAT. 16 Furniture, small. Under 500mm² footprint, approximately.
- CAT. 17 Item featuring pyrographic technique on wood.
- CAT. 18 Toy, model or novelty item comprised predominately of wood.
- CAT. 19 A set of three wooden pens. Your choice of presentation, however the presentation is not part of the evaluation process.
- CAT. 20 Any wooden musical instrument

Each category will be judged on: Design and Originality, Craftsmanship, Skilled Execution, Difficulty, Complexity, Standard of Finish and Aesthetics-Wow Factor
